

“Interpretations of the City” Annual Juried Art Competition

Tutoring Solutions of Atlanta invites submissions for its annual juried art competition. Artists are encouraged to share their vision of the theme “Interpretations of the City.” The competition is open to all students enrolled in high schools and home school organizations in Atlanta regardless of current or previous art class enrollment. There is no entry fee, but is limited to one entry per student.

Submitted works must be original, from the hand of a single artist, and in two dimensions in any traditional media, such as, but not limited to: oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel, mixed media, gouache, egg tempera, pen and ink, graphite, charcoal, colored pencils, scratch board, markers, metal point, and two-dimensional collage and fabric art. No digital art, photography, or three-dimensional art, such as installation art or sculpture will be judged. All works must be original and from the hand of a single artist. Compositions based on published material or other artists’ work are not considered original and are not eligible.

Art must be submitted matted or mounted suitable for framing with the final product conforming to one of the following frame sizes in inches.

12 x 16, 16 x 20, 19 3/4 x 19 3/4, 19 3/4 x 27 1/2, 24 x 35 1/4

Stretched canvas pieces will not be framed and may be any dimensions size 24 x 36 or smaller.

Pieces will be judged on creativity, originality, applicability to the theme, and skilled use of the media chosen. The top entry from each school or organization will be framed and displayed in our office and featured on our website until May 2018, after which, framed art will be returned. Three prize winners will be chosen and receive \$250, \$100, and \$50, respectively.

Deadline for submission is October 12th, at which time all entries must be delivered to one of our office locations or picked up at participating schools by the contest coordinator. Winners will be notified by email October 20th.

All pieces not chosen for display will be returned to the school within two months of submission.
